**15-Day Comment Period on 2023 Performance Report for
Affordable Housing and Community Development Programs**

Notice

Snohomish County is making the Draft 2023 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (**Draft 2023 CAPER**) available for public review and comment for 15 days beginning on September 10, 2024, through September 24, 2024.

Information about the CAPER

Snohomish County, in consortium with the cities and towns in the county, receives three grants from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and grant funds to address the COVID-19 pandemic:

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)
- HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME)
- Community Development Block Grant-Coronavirus (CDBG-CV)

Grant funds are used to support affordable housing and community development projects in the county that primarily benefit low-and moderate-income people and neighborhoods. The CDBG-CV funds were made available to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus. The Draft 2023 CAPER describes how grant funds were used from July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, and assesses progress towards annual and five-year goals for the grant programs.
